11	"(b) For a second offense of violating Section 45-13-9 by
12	selling fireworks on a date other than the dates authorized for
13	the retail sale of fireworks, the offender is guilty of a

- 14 misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a
- 15 fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or
- 16 imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1)
- 17 year, or both.
- 18 (c) For a third or subsequent offense of violating
- 19 Section 45-13-9 by selling fireworks on a date other than the
- 20 dates authorized for the retail sale of fireworks, the offender is
- 21 guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished
- 22 by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or
- 23 imprisonment in the county jail or custody of the Mississippi
- 24 Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed one (1) year,
- 25 or both."

- 27 after the word "MISDEMEANOR" on line 9: "AND PROVIDE THAT A THIRD
- 28 OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE IS A FELONY"
