AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

1 **AMEND** on line 351 after the second comma by inserting "as
2 amended by House Bill No. 565, 2025 Regular Session,".

3 **AMEND further** on line 355-356 by deleting the following in
4 its entirety: ", Mississippi Code of 1972,".

5 **AMEND further** on lines 363, 365, 368 and 370 by inserting "or
6 her" after "his".

7 **AMEND further** on lines 365, 369 and 370 by inserting "or she"
8 after "he".

9 **AMEND further** by inserting the following after line 478:



10 "(11) (a) Any full- or part-time law enforcement officer,
11 who is certified as required by the provisions under this chapter,
12 and such officer resigns from his or her law enforcement agency,
13 then the agency that the officer has resigned from shall notify
14 the board in writing and by email within seventy-two (72) hours of
15 the officer's resignation.

16 (b) If any full- or part-time law enforcement officer
17 is terminated or resigns due to disciplinary action, the law
18 enforcement agency shall notify the board within seventy-two (72)
19 hours of the termination or resignation, as the case may be, and
20 the agency shall provide in writing and by email to the board, the
21 explanation for the termination or resignation of the officer.
22 The required explanation of such termination or resignation shall
23 be submitted, along with the required notification, within the
24 same seventy-two (72) hour time frame as required under this
25 subsection.

26 (c) If a law enforcement agency fails to adhere to the
27 reporting requirements of this subsection, as determined by the
28 board, then such agency:

29 (i) Shall not be eligible for state grants or
30 other subsidiary funding provided by the state; and

31 (ii) Shall not receive reimbursement for
32 continuing education requirements as provided under Section 45-6-
33 19.



34 (d) When the board determines that a law enforcement
35 agency failed to adhere to the reporting requirements of this
36 subsection, notice and opportunity for a hearing shall be provided
37 by the board in accordance with law prior to the failure of the
38 reporting.

39 (e) Any law enforcement agency that is aggrieved by any
40 order or ruling made under the provisions of this subsection has
41 the same rights and procedure of appeal as from any other order or
42 ruling of the board.

43 (f) The board is authorized to institute and promulgate
44 all rules necessary for implementing the requirements set out
45 under this subsection (11)."

50 **AMEND further** by inserting the following language after line
51 5358 and renumber the succeeding subsections:

52 "(2) Licensed practical nurse applicant qualifications for
53 military medics. Any applicant for a license to practice
54 practical nursing as a licensed practical nurse who is a United
55 States Army Combat Medic Specialist, a United States Navy Hospital



Corpsman, or a United States Air Force Aerospace Medical Service Specialist shall submit to the board:

(a) An attested written application on a Board of Nursing form;

(b) A diploma from an approved high school or the equivalent thereof, as determined by the appropriate educational agency;

(c) Written official evidence of completion of the training required for a United States Army Combat Medic Specialist, a United States Navy Hospital Corpsman, or a United States Air Force Aerospace Medical Service Specialist, and after such training, completion of two (2) years of clinical experience that involves providing direct patient care, which may include trauma or emergency oriented care;

(d) Evidence of competence in English related to nursing, provided the first language is not English;

(e) Any other official records required by the board."
