Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 724

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 97-13-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 97-13-13. (1) If any person shall take or remove any ballot 10 from a voting place before the close of the polls, he <u>or she</u> 11 shall, on conviction, be imprisoned in the county jail not more 12 than one (1) year, or be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars 13 (\$1,000.00), or both.

14 (2) If any person assisting an elector with voting in 15 accordance with Section 23-15-907 willfully fails to transmit the 16 ballot that was mailed to the elector with the intent of the 17 ballot not being cast and counted in the election, the person 18 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be 19 imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, and 20 subject to a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars

21 (\$1,000.00).

22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after July 1, 2025.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-13-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CREATE A CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR SOMEONE WHO ASSISTS AN ELECTOR WITH CASTING A BALLOT, BUT WILLFULLY FAILS TO TURN IN THE BALLOT WITH THE INTENT OF THE BALLOT NOT BEING CAST OR COUNTED IN THE ELECTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
