Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1127

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

- AMEND by deleting Section 27 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 SECTION *. Section 4 of Chapter 509, Laws of 2024, is
- 4 amended as follows:
- 5 Section 4. (1) The Legislature, based upon current United
- 6 States Treasury guidance, has determined that all Coronavirus
- 7 State Fiscal Recovery Funds must be obligated by December 31,
- 8 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026.
- 9 (2) (a) In order to meet the obligation deadline set forth
- 10 by the United States Treasury, the State Fiscal Officer shall
- 11 determine the amount of Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds
- 12 appropriated to various agencies that will not be obligated as of
- 13 October 1, 2024.
- 14 (b) In making the determination required by this
- 15 section, the State Fiscal Officer shall use the guidance released
- 16 by the United States Treasury to determine if the Coronavirus
- 17 State Fiscal Recovery Funds are not obligated.

- 18 (3) If at any time during the period from passage of this
- 19 act to October 1, 2024, a state agency determines that Coronavirus
- 20 State Fiscal Recovery Funds will not be obligated by October 1,
- 21 2024, the state agency shall notify the State Fiscal Officer.
- 22 (4) If at any time the State Fiscal Officer determines that
- 23 funds will be unobligated as of October 1, 2024, under subsection
- 24 (2) or (3) of this section, the State Treasurer, in coordination
- 25 with the State Fiscal Officer, shall transfer these funds to the
- 26 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund (Fund No. 682111300) by no
- 27 later than October 5, 2024. The State Fiscal Officer may retain
- 28 an amount not to exceed the lesser of the estimated cost of ARPA
- 29 administration or Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) in
- 30 the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund to be utilized for
- 31 administrative and reporting costs. No later than October 6,
- 32 2024, the State Treasurer, in conjunction with the State Fiscal
- 33 Officer, shall transfer the funds to the ARPA-MDOT Maintenance
- 34 Project Fund.
- 35 (5) If at any time the State Fiscal Officer determines that
- 36 funds are deobligated after October 5, 2024, the State Fiscal
- 37 Officer, in conjunction with the State Treasurer, shall transfer
- 38 the deobligated funds to the ARPA MDOT Maintenance Project Fund.
- FURTHER, AMEND the title to conform.
