Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1725

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters 8 9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board 10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 11 62,755.00. 12 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 13 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 15 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 16 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 17 Year 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 18 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be 19 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 20 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process. 21

It is the intention of the Legislature that 23 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 24 25 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 26 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 27 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 28 29 made without competitive bids.

30 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 31 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 32 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 33 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 34 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 35 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 36 actions contrary to this provision.

37 SECTION 5. Of the fund appropriated under the provisions of 38 Section 1 of this act, Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-six 39 Dollars (\$18,626.00) is provided for database upgrades and other 40 improvements to the board's licensing system.

41 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 42 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 43 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 44 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 45 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 46 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

H. B. 1725 PAGE 2 47 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after July 1, 2025, and shall stand repealed from and after 49 June 30, 2025.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
