## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1732

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	special source funds which are received by or otherwise become
8	available to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the
9	purpose of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal
10	year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026
11	\$ 22,815,388.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 100
16	Time-Limited: 1
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
19	Services for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2026 funds
20	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
21	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the Mississippi
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- 22 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
- 23 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
- 24 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
- 25 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
- 26 2026 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2025
- 27 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
- 28 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
- 29 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
- 30 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
- 31 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
- 32 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
- 33 Mississippi State Personnel Board.
- 34 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
- 35 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
- 36 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 37 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2026 do
- 38 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 39 the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 projected cost exceeds the
- 40 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 41 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 42 essential for the agency.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 44 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 45 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 46 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 47 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

- 48 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 49 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 50 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 51 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 54 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 55 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 57 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A
- 58 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 59 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 60 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 61 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete
- 62 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 63 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 64 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 65 Year 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 66 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be
- 67 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 68 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 69 provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.
- 70 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 71 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 72 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 73 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

- 74 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 75 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 76 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 77 made without competitive bids.
- 78 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 79 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
- 80 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
- 81 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
- 82 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
- 83 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 84 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 85 **SECTION 6.** None of the funds appropriated for expenditure
- 86 under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply
- 87 District until the district agrees to comply with the following
- 88 condition: the District shall waive traffic control fees for any
- 89 vehicle displaying a "REZ" tag.
- 90 **SECTION 7.** None of the funds appropriated for expenditure
- 91 under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply
- 92 District until the district agrees to comply with the following
- 93 conditions: (1) If any local governmental or nonprofit entity
- 94 wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major
- 95 Open, these events shall be exempt from the district's lottery
- 96 system for host events at the reservoir and given priority of any
- 97 and all date options available. (2) If any local governmental or
- 98 nonprofit entity wins the bid for such events, the district shall
- 99 waive the daily launch fees or any other special event fees for

100	the	ESPN	Bass	Masters	Classic	or	the	FLW	Mai	or	Open.	(3)	The

- 101 Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic shall be held on the first
- 102 Sunday in May unless any local governmental or nonprofit entity
- 103 wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major
- 104 Open on that date. The Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic
- 105 shall be exempt from the district's lottery system for host events
- 106 at the reservoir and given priority for the first Sunday in May.
- 107 The district shall waive the daily launch fees or any other
- 108 special event fees for the Classic.
- 109 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Two Hundred
- 110 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided for the purpose of
- 111 funding overtime, callback or standby pay.
- 112 **SECTION 9.** Funds are provided herein out of the Ross Barnett
- 113 Reservoir Dredging Fund for dredging and other related activities
- 114 to remove sediments and debris from the bottom of the Ross Barnett
- 115 Reservoir.
- SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 117 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital
- 118 Expense Fund, not otherwise appropriated for Pearl River Valley
- 119 Water Supply District for the purpose of reauthorizing the
- 120 expenditure of Capital Expense Funds, as authorized in HB 1631,
- 121 2023 Regular Session, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
- 122 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District for the fiscal year
- 123 beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026......
- 124 .....\$ 1,598,970.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,

126 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this

127 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds

128 remaining as of June 30, 2025, from the amount authorized for the

129 previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not

130 change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

131 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions

of Section 1 of this act, Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) is

133 provided for the construction of a new office building.

134 **SECTION 12.** The funds herein appropriated shall be expended

in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972,

136 that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in

excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers,

138 either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held

139 responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

140 **SECTION 13.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall

be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer

or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with

143 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

144 **SECTION 14.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

145 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

147 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

148 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

149 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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- 150 **SECTION 15.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 151 and after July 1, 2025, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 152 June 30, 2025.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.
