Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1743

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the 8 expenses of the State Fire Academy for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.....\$ 6,854,812.00. SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 10 11 Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 12 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT: 62 13 Permanent: 14 Time-Limited: \cap 15 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 16 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal Services for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2026 funds 17 18 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are 19 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the Mississippi

Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's

personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board

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- 22 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
- 23 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
- 24 2026 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2025
- 25 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
- 26 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
- 27 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
- 28 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
- 29 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
- 30 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
- 31 Mississippi State Personnel Board.
- 32 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
- 33 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
- 34 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 35 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2026 do
- 36 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 37 the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 projected cost exceeds the
- 38 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 39 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 40 essential for the agency.
- 41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 43 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

SECTION 3. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets
set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the
agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget

74 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

75 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and

76 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

77 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

78 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year

79 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

80 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be submitted to

81 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

82 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

83 during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.

84 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

87 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

89 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

90 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

91 made without competitive bids.

92 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

93 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with

94 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

95 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their

96 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

97 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for

98 actions contrary to this provision.

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99 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 100 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 101 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the State Fire 102 Academy for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of 103 Capital Expense Funds as authorized in House Bill 1798, 2024 104 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025 and 1,825,000.00. 105 ending June 30, 2026.....\$

- This re-appropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorzing the expenditure of funds as allocated herein:
- a) Federal Grant Match to Purchase Vehicles..\$ 75,000.00.
- b) Replacement of Heat Building Components...\$ 1,750,000.00.
- Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
- 111 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
- 112 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds
- 113 remaining as of June 30, 2025, from the amount authorized for the
- 114 previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not
- 115 change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.
- SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 117 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 118 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 119 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 120 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 121 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 122 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 123 and after July 1, 2025, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 124 June 30, 2025.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM GENERAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE FIRE ACADEMY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.
