Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

38 SECTION 1. (1) Various segments of the state public roadway system in the State of Mississippi shall be designated as 39 40 "Memorial Highways," "Memorial Roads" or "Memorial Bridges" in 41 honor of the several individuals for whom resolutions, officially 42 and duly adopted by the relevant local governing authorities, and spread upon its minutes, requesting the designations of such, have 43 44 been provided to the Transportation Committees of the Mississippi 45 House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate indicating the 46 desire for the identified segments to be so named.



- 47 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 48 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segments
- 49 of the roadway to be described as prescribed in this section.
- 50 **SECTION 2.** (1) A segment of Old Mississippi Highway 25
- 51 North located in Itawamba County, Mississippi, the specification
- 52 of its points of commencement and terminus to be determined by the
- 53 Itawamba County Board of Supervisors, and extending for a distance
- 54 of one (1) mile, shall be known as the "Chief Warrant Officer
- 55 Derek Abbott Memorial Highway."
- 56 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 57 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 58 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- 59 **SECTION 3.** (1) A segment of Fairview Banner Road located in
- 60 Itawamba County, Mississippi, the specification of its points of
- 61 commencement and terminus to be determined by the Itawamba County
- 62 Board of Supervisors, and extending for a distance of one (1)
- 63 mile, shall be known as the "Larry Cromeans Memorial Highway."
- 64 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 65 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- 67 **SECTION 4.** (1) The entire segment of Interstate 22
- 68 traversing through DeSoto, Marshall, Benton, Union, Pontotoc, Lee
- 69 and Itawamba Counties, Mississippi, beginning at the convergence
- 70 of Interstate 269 with U.S. Highway 78 in Byhalia, Mississippi,
- 71 and extending southeasterly to its ending at the



- 72 Mississippi-Alabama state line, in conjunction with that portion
- 73 of U.S. Highway 78, which converges with Interstate 269 in
- 74 Byhalia, Mississippi, and extending northwesterly to its ending at
- 75 the Mississippi-Tennessee state line, is designated and shall be
- 76 known as the "Medal of Honor Trail."
- 77 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 78 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 79 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- SECTION 5. (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 19 South
- 81 located in Neshoba County, Mississippi, north of the Neshoba
- 82 County-Newton County line, extending for a distance of
- 83 approximately one (1) mile in the northerly direction to the
- 84 southbound lane of its intersection with County Road 709, is
- 85 designated and shall be known as the "MSqt. Bridgette R. Horn
- 86 Memorial Highway."
- 87 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 88 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 89 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section. The
- 90 signage assembly to be erected along and approaching the segment
- 91 of highway described in subsection (1) shall include the "End of
- 92 Watch" date for MSqt. Bridgette R. Horn, as November 19, 2020.
- 93 **SECTION 6.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 9 South
- 94 located in Pontotoc County, Mississippi, commencing at a point
- 95 approximately two hundred (200) feet north of Gilmer Road, and
- 96 extending for a distance of approximately one (1) mile in the

- 97 southerly direction to a point of its intersection near Ward
- 98 Drive, is designated and shall be known as the "Meaghan Bedford
- 99 Reed Memorial Highway."
- 100 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 101 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 102 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- 103 **SECTION 7.** (1) The Strong River Bridge, which is a segment
- 104 of Mississippi Highway 149, located in Simpson County,
- 105 Mississippi, is designated and shall be known as the
- 106 "Badger-Malone-Igleharte Memorial Bridge," in honor of Mr. Charles
- 107 Badger, Mr. Kevin Malone and Mr. Charles Igleharte, who were
- 108 victims of the bridge collapse over the Strong River on October
- 109 16, 2024.
- 110 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 111 and maintain an appropriate plaque at each end of the bridge and
- 112 suitable markers along and approaching the bridge, described in
- 113 subsection (1) of this section.
- 114 **SECTION 8.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 366
- 115 located in Prentiss County, Mississippi, commencing at its
- 116 intersection with Highway 371 and extending in the westerly
- 117 direction for a distance of one-half (1/2) mile, shall be known as
- 118 the "Houston 'Dale' Kennedy Memorial Highway."
- 119 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 120 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
- 121 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

- 125 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 126 and maintain an appropriate plaque at each end of the bridge, and 127 suitable markers along and approaching the bridge, described in 128 subsection (1) of this section.
- SECTION 10. (1) The bridge on U.S. Route 72 that spans

 Turner Creek in Corinth, Alcorn County, Mississippi, is designated

 and shall be known as the "Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge."
- 132 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 133 and maintain an appropriate plaque at each end of the bridge, and 134 suitable markers along and approaching the bridge, described in 135 subsection (1) of this section.
- Jasper County, Mississippi, from its intersection with Mississippi
 Highway 528 and extending north to its intersection with County
 Road 31, shall be known as the "Timothy Jones-Willie Jones-George
 Hilton Stephenson-Adam J. Sims-Johnny Lee Jones Sr. Memorial
 Road."
- 142 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 143 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment 144 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.
- 145 **SECTION 12.** The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs at the eastbound and

- 147 westbound lanes of U.S. Route 84 in Lincoln County, Mississippi,

- 35 MISSISSIPPI, APPROACHING THE INTERSECTION WITH MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
- 36 583; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
