AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Joint Resolution No. 202

BY: Senator(s) Simmons (12th)

**Amend by striking all after line 4 and inserting in lieu
thereof the following:**

5 WHEREAS, in its July 2, 2024, opinion, the United States
6 District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi, in the
7 case styled Mississippi State Conf. of the NAACP v. State Bd. of
8 Election Comm'rs., No. 3:22-CV-734, concluded that the Plaintiffs
9 had shown violations of Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act.
10 Specifically, the Court found the Plaintiffs had shown that two
11 (2) Senate districts did not satisfy the framework of Thornburg v.
12 Gingles, 478 U.S. 30 (1986); and
13 WHEREAS, to remedy those violations, the Court recognized
14 that redistricting is primarily the duty and responsibility of the



15 State through its Legislature or other body, rather than a federal
16 court, and further stated that the Mississippi Legislature would
17 be given an opportunity to create new districts, and ultimately
18 elections would be needed in all reformed districts; and

19 WHEREAS, on July 18, 2024, after considering options, the
20 Court gave the Mississippi Legislature until the conclusion of the
21 2025 Regular Session to develop a remedial plan; and

22 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Legislature has reviewed the orders
23 of the Court in the above-styled case and has prepared amendments
24 to the Mississippi State Senate Redistricting plan adopted in
25 2022, thereby creating two (2) new State Senate Districts wherein
26 minorities will have an opportunity to elect a candidate of their
27 choice while limiting the ripple effect to existing districts as
28 much as reasonably possible:

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
30 STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, that Chapter 2150, Laws of 2022, is amended
31 as follows:

32 "BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
33 MISSISSIPPI, That the Senate shall consist of fifty-two (52)
34 Senators who shall be elected from fifty-two (52) single-member
35 districts, composed as follows:

504 State the Split Precinct Block List developed in conjunction with

511 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the boundaries of the senatorial

522 (1) This joint resolution shall be liberally construed to
523 effectuate the purposes thereof and to redistrict the Senate
524 districts of this state in compliance with constitutional
525 requirements. It is the intent of the Legislature that this joint
526 resolution, and the districts described herein, completely
527 encompass all the area within the state. It is also intended that
528 such districts contain all the inhabitants in this state. It is
529 further intended that the redistricting provided for in this joint
530 resolution results in the creation of districts that are as close
531 to equal in population as permissible under law. It is also
532 intended that no district shall contain any of the area included
533 within the description of another district.



534 (2) If the districts described in this joint resolution do
535 not carry out the purposes thereof because of unintentional
536 omissions, duplications, overlapping areas, erroneous
537 nomenclature, lack of adequate maps or descriptions of political
538 subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of their
539 boundary lines, then the Secretary of State, at the request of the
540 Chair or Vice Chairman of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee
541 on Reapportionment shall, by order, correct such omissions,
542 overlaps, erroneous nomenclature or other defects in the
543 description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and
544 objectives of this joint resolution.

545 (3) In promulgating such orders, the Secretary of State, in
546 addition to achieving equality in the population of districts as
547 permissible under law and ensuring that all areas of the state
548 are completely and accurately encompassed in such districts, shall
549 be guided by the following standards:

550 (a) In any instance in which there is a conflict
551 between the description of a district as provided in this joint
552 resolution and the map of the Senate districts developed by the
553 Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment in
554 conjunction with the adopted redistricting plan, the map shall
555 control; however, in instances in which the map is inconclusive,
556 the criteria provided in paragraphs (b) through (f) of this
557 subsection shall control any dispute or issue regarding the
558 composition of any Senate district;



559 (b) Gaps in the description of a district shall be
560 completed in a manner that results in a total description of the
561 district that is consonant with the description of adjacent
562 districts and results in complete contiguity of districts;

563 (c) Areas of the state included within the descriptions
564 of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district
565 having the lowest population;

566 (d) Areas of the state not included within the
567 descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent
568 district having the lowest population;

569 (e) In the event that the area subject to corrected
570 description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (b), (c) and
571 (d) of this subsection is of such size or contains such population
572 that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in
573 substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of the
574 district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of the
575 area to two (2) or more districts; and

576 (f) In any allocation of area or correction of
577 descriptions made pursuant to this joint resolution, the Secretary
578 of State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve
579 the contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the
580 unnecessary division of political subdivisions.

581 (4) Copies of such orders shall be filed by the Secretary of
582 State in his office and in the offices of the affected
583 commissioners of election and registrars. The Secretary of State



584 may adopt reasonable rules regulating the procedure for
585 applications for orders under this joint resolution in the manner
586 of serving and filing a notice or copy of orders relating thereto.
587 Upon the filing of an order, the description of any affected
588 district shall be deemed to have been corrected in the manner
589 provided in such order to the full extent as if the correction had
590 been contained in the original description provided in this joint
591 resolution.

592 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Standing Joint Legislative
593 Committee on Reapportionment is directed to provide all
594 information necessary to assist the counties in identifying the
595 boundaries of the districts described in this joint resolution.

596 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
597 this joint resolution shall supersede any prior redistricting, and
598 any prior redistricting shall be null and void upon the date this
599 joint resolution is effectuated.

600 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman
601 of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment
602 shall file copies of this plan with the Mississippi Department of
603 Archives and History, the Secretary of State, the Clerk of the
604 Mississippi House of Representatives, and the Secretary of the
605 Mississippi State Senate.

606 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if any paragraph, sentence,
607 clause, phrase or any part of this joint resolution is declared to
608 be unconstitutional or void, or if for any reason is declared to



609 be invalid or of no effect, the remaining paragraphs, sentences,
610 clauses, phrases or parts thereof shall be in no manner affected
611 thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

612 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting of House of
613 Representatives districts and Senate districts shall be deemed to
614 be separate from each other. The invalidity of the districts of
615 one (1) house shall not affect or require the redistricting of the
616 other house.

617 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Legislative Committee
618 on Compilation, Revision and Publication of Legislation is hereby
619 directed to see to it that this resolution is placed in the
620 editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code of
621 1972.

622 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Senate Rules
623 Committee, with the assistance of counsel, is hereby directed to
624 submit this resolution, upon its adoption by both houses of the
625 Legislature, to the United States District Court for the Southern
626 District of Mississippi, Northern Division, in the matter styled
627 Mississippi State Conf. of the NAACP v. State Bd. of Election
628 Comm'rs., No. 3:22-CV-734.

629 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in redrawing the new Senate
630 districts and affected surrounding districts, an effort was made
631 to minimize the number of affected districts so as to reduce the
632 confusion for the voters and the burden on local election
633 officials in administering elections.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is the intention of the Legislature that all Senate elections conducted in districts amended by this joint resolution, and held in 2025, be administered in accordance with the following schedule:

April 25: Deadline for delivery of detailed maps and address libraries to local election officials.

May 19: Qualifying begins.

May 30: Qualifying deadline.

June 6: Deadline for State Executive Committees to submit names of qualified candidates.

June 21: The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act, PL 99-110, 100 Stat. 924, (UOCAVA) absentee voting begins for special primary election.

August 5: Special Primary Election Day.

September 2: Special Primary Runoff Election Day.

September 20: UOCAVA absentee voting begins for special general election.

November 4: Special General Election Day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the United States District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi, Northern Division, in the matter styled Mississippi State Conf. of the NAACP v. State Bd. of Election Comm'rs., No. 3:22-CV-734."
