AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill No. 2201

1 **AMEND by inserting the following after line 19 as a new**
2 **paragraph:**

3 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of
4 this subsection, a municipality may adopt, enact, or enforce an
5 ordinance authorizing the use of automated recording equipment or
6 systems to enforce compliance with traffic laws within designated
7 school zones during posted school hours. Such equipment or
8 systems may be used to detect and record violations related to
9 speed limits or traffic signals to enhance the safety of children,
10 pedestrians, and school personnel.

11 **FURTHER, AMEND by inserting the following after line 29 as a**
12 **new subsection (3):**



13 (3) Any automated recording equipment or system used under
14 the exemption in subsection (1)(c) shall meet the following
15 requirements:

16 (a) Be clearly marked with signage indicating the
17 presence of automated enforcement within the school zone;

18 (b) Operate only during posted school hours or when
19 children are visibly present in the area;

20 (c) Capture clear photographic or video evidence of
21 violations, including the vehicle's license plate, photo of the
22 driver, and speed at the time of the offense; and

23 (d) Allow for a process in which motorists can contest
24 citations issued under this provision.
