AMEND by inserting the following new Section 6 and renumbering subsequent sections accordingly:

- 3 **SECTION 6.** (1) A task force is established to conduct a
- 4 study of alternative funding programs and their effect on patient
- 5 access to affordable prescription drugs in Mississippi. The task
- 6 force shall consist of the members of the Mississippi Rare Disease
- 7 Advisory Council or their designees.
- 8 (2) The council's physician member shall chair the task
- 9 force, and the council staff shall provide the task force with
- 10 administrative support.
- 11 (3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes
- 12 a quorum, and all actions of the task force shall require a
- 13 majority vote of the members present and voting.



- 14 (4) The chair shall convene the first meeting by May 15,
- 15 2025. Members shall serve without compensation but may receive
- 16 travel reimbursement per Section 25-3-41.
- 17 (5) The study shall assess: (a) Alternative funding programs
- 18 and their effect on patient access to affordable prescription
- 19 drugs; and (b) The impact of those programs on patient assistance
- 20 programs for prescription medications and insurance coverage.
- 21 (6) The task force shall submit a report of its findings and
- 22 recommendations by December 1, 2025, to the Governor, the Speaker
- 23 of the House of Representatives, the Lieutenant Governor, the
- 24 House and Senate Chairs of the Public Health Committees, and the
- 25 House and Senate Chairs of the Medicaid Committees.
- 26 (7) The task force shall be dissolved upon submission of its
- 27 report.
- 28 AMEND, FURTHER the title by inserting the following language
- 29 after the semicolon on line 15:
- 30 TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY ALTERNATIVE FUNDING PROGRAMS AND
- 31 THEIR EFFECT ON PATIENT ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS IN
- 32 MISSISSIPPI;
