## AMEND by inserting the following below line 431:

- 3 Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA) and as amended, beginning July
- 4 1, 2025, individuals who are under sixty-five (65) years of age,
- 5 not pregnant, not entitled to nor enrolled for benefits in Part A

Under the federal Patient Protection and

- ${\color{blue} 6}$  of Title XVIII of the federal Social Security Act or enrolled for
- 7 benefits in Part B of Title XVIII of the federal Social Security
- 8 Act, are not described in any other part of this section, and
- 9 whose income does not exceed one hundred thirty-three percent
- 10 (133%) of the Federal Poverty Level applicable to a family of the
- 11 size involved. The eligibility of individuals covered under this

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- 12 paragraph (29) shall be determined by the Division of Medicaid,
- 13 and those individuals determined eligible shall only receive
- 14 essential health benefits as described in the federal Patient
- 15 Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA) as amended. This
- 16 paragraph (29) shall stand repealed on December 31, 2027.
- 17 AMEND by inserting the following below line 1349:
- 18 (66) Beginning July 1, 2025, essential health benefits
- 19 as described in the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care
- 20 Act of 2010 (ACA) and as amended, for individuals eligible for
- 21 Medicaid under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care
- 22 Act of 2010 (ACA) as amended, as described in Section
- 23 43-13-115(29) of this article. These services shall be provided
- 24 only so long as the Medicaid federal matching percentage is not
- 25 less than ninety percent (90%) for Medicaid services to this
- 26 population. This paragraph (66) shall stand repealed on December
- 27 31, 2027.
- FURTHER, AMEND the title to conform by inserting the
- 29 following after the semicolon on line 15:
- 30 TO REVISE MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY TO INCLUDE THOSE INDIVIDUALS WHO
- 31 ARE ENTITLED TO BENEFITS UNDER THE FEDERAL PATIENT PROTECTION AND
- 32 AFFORDABLE CARE ACT OF 2010 (ACA), AS AMENDED;
- FURTHER, AMEND the title to conform by inserting the
- 34 following after the semicolon on line 78:
- 35 TO INCLUDE ESSENTIAL HEALTH BENEFITS FOR INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE FOR
- 36 MEDICAID UNDER THE FEDERAL PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE
- 37 ACT OF 2010 (ACA), AS AMENDED;
