- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 20 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 21 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 22 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 23 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 24 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain
- 25 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 26 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 27 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 28 maintained for Fiscal Year 2025. It is further the intention of
- 29 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 30 2027 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 31 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level

- 34 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

- 39 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- 42 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated herein, One Hundred
- 43 Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00) is provided for the

- 45 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 46 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall only expend
- 47 funds on activities directly related to the operation of the state

- 49 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 50 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 51 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 52 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 53 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 55 actions contrary to this provision.
- 56 **SECTION 8.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 57 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 58 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 59 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 60 and after July 1, 2025.
