HOUSE BILL NO. 26

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF OPTOMETRY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of
8	Optometry, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
10	June 30, 2026\$ 256,272.00.
11	SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
12	accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established
13	by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
14	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
15	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
16	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
17	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
18	State Board of Optometry shall maintain complete accounting and

- 19 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 20 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 21 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 22 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 23 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be submitted to
- 24 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 25 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 26 during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.
- 27 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 28 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 29 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 30 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 31 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 32 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 33 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 34 made without competitive bids.
- 35 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 36 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 37 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 38 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 39 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 40 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 41 actions contrary to this provision.
- 42 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 43 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

- 44 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 45 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 46 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 47 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 48 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2025.
