| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 7 | necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury |
| 8 | to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy, |
| 9 | for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State |
| 10 | Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year beginning |
| 11 | July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026\$ 354,726.00. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of |
| 13 | this act, not more than the following amount of funds, with the |
| 14 | exception of the provisions in this section, shall be expended |
| 15 | only for "Personal Services," which includes "Vacancy Funding," |
| 16 | for the following authorized number of employment headcount: |

| With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's |
|--|
| responsibility to ensure that no single personnel action or |
| combination of personnel actions, when annualized, exceeds the |
| Fiscal Year 2026 appropriation for "Personal Services" with the |
| exception of escalated funds. Further, it shall be the agency's |
| responsibility to ensure that funds required to be appropriated |
| for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal |
| Year 2026 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or |
| positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the |
| Mississippi Legislature. |
| If, at the time the agency takes any action to change |
| "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the |
| agency has taken or will take an action that would cause the |
| agency to exceed the funds appropriated in this act when |
| annualized for Fiscal Year 2026 or increase the need for "Personal |
| Services" for Fiscal Year 2027, when annualized, the State |
| Personnel Board shall process no salary actions until such time as |
| the requirements of the provisions of this section are met with |
| the exception of new hires determined to be essential for the |
| agency. |
| When used in this section, "Vacancy Funding" shall mean funds |
| included in the Total Personal Services amount listed above and |
| designated for approved vacancies in Fiscal Year 2026. These funds |
| are to be utilized to increase the number of filled headcounts |
| |

that were authorized but unfilled as of the last day of Fiscal

- 70 Year 2025. If the agency fills additional headcounts after May 1,
- 71 2025, until the end of Fiscal Year 2025, the amount of available
- 72 Vacancy Funding may be proportionally reduced to reflect the
- 73 updated number of filled headcounts. The agency shall be
- 74 responsible for ensuring that "Vacancy Funding" is used to
- 75 increase headcounts and not for promotions, title changes,
- 76 in-range salary adjustments, or any other mechanism for increasing
- 77 salaries for current employees.
- 78 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 79 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 80 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 81 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 82 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 83 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 84 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or headcounts
- 85 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 86 appropriated level. Unless specifically noted, all Fiscal Year
- 87 2025 escalated headcounts have been accounted for and shall be
- 88 converted to authorized time-limited headcounts.
- 89 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 90 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 91 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 92 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 94 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A

- 95 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 96 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 97 If the agency's total authorized headcount decreases from
- 98 Fiscal Year 2025 to Fiscal Year 2026, it will be the agency's
- 99 discretion as to what headcounts are removed.
- 100 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 101 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain
- 102 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 103 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 104 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 105 maintained for Fiscal Year 2025. It is further the intention of
- 106 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 107 2027 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 108 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 109 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request
- 110 process.
- 111 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 112 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 113 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 114 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 115 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 116 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 117 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 118 made without competitive bids.

| 119 | SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the |

| 120 | funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with |
| 121 | Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency |
| 122 | shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their |
| 123 | appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally |
| 124 | or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for |
| 125 | actions contrary to this provision. |
| 126 | SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by |
| 127 | the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the |
| 128 | credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon |
| 129 | warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal |
| 130 | Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the |
| 131 | proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law |
| 132 | SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from |
| 133 | and after July 1 2025 |
