3	PHOTOGRAPHER FOR THE WIRE SERVICE'S JACKSON OFFICE PHOTO.
4	WHEREAS, veteran photojournalist Rogelio V. Solis retired

- from The Associated Press in January 2025 after dedicating nearly 5
- three decades as chief photographer for the wire service's Jackson 6
- 7 office; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a native of El Paso, Texas, Mr. Solis has lived in
- 9 Mississippi since 1970, and he received a mass communications
- 10 degree from Jackson State University and a photojournalism degree
- 11 from the University of Missouri; and
- 12 WHEREAS, before he began working for The Associated Press,
- 13 where he won numerous awards for his photojournalism, Mr. Solis
- 14 was a photographer with the Meridian Star newspaper and the Houma
- Daily Courier in Louisiana, and he also served for three years as 15
- 16 photographer for former Governor Ray Mabus' administration; and
- 17 WHEREAS, through his lens, Mr. Solis presented Mississippi to
- 18 the world, as his photographs have been published locally,

- 19 nationally and internationally, and he chronicled Mississippi's
- 20 most celebrated moments, including monumental sports victories,
- 21 and its low points, including the massive destruction of
- 22 hurricanes and other natural disasters as well as man-made
- 23 calamity with criminal cases and trials; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Mr. Solis truly has a gift for capturing images that
- 25 convey people's personalities, whether amid the devastation of
- 26 Hurricane Katrina or during floor debates in the Mississippi House
- 27 and Senate; and
- 28 WHEREAS, additionally, Mr. Solis was a high school classmate
- 29 and friend of Deborah Hays, who eventually married Phil Bryant in
- 30 1976, and when she became the state's first lady in January 2012,
- 31 she provided a thorough tour of the Governor's Mansion for Mr.
- 32 Solis, allowing him to capture memorable photos of the historic
- 33 building, including from the rooftop; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Mr. Solis's photographs have shown the good, the
- 35 bad, the ugly and the beautiful, and will live on as an important
- 36 visual documentation of the Magnolia State's history, and he was
- 37 often recognized by The Associated Press for shooting some of the
- 38 most remarkable photos of the day or week nationwide, which
- 39 received the AP TopPix designation; and
- 40 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 41 recognize and commend the tireless devotion to the betterment of
- 42 Mississippi and honor the ardent vow to impeccable service that
- 43 Mr. Rogelio V. Solis provided to The Associated Press for three
