1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL GEOLOGISTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Board of Registered
8	Professional Geologists for the purpose of defraying the expenses
9	of the board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and
10	ending June 30, 2026\$ 144,816.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	this act, not more than the following amount of funds, with the
13	exception of the provisions in this section, shall be expended
14	only for "Personal Services," which includes "Vacancy Funding,"
15	for the following authorized number of employment headcount:

29	As used in this section, the term '	`Pers	onal Services" shall
30	mean funds provided under the major obje	ect o	f expenditure category
31	Personal Services for Salaries, Wages, a	and F	ringe Benefits. Funds
32	in this category shall not be transferred	ed to	any other category.
33	It is the intention of the Legislat	ure	to ensure compliance
34	with the Variable Compensation Plan, as	outl	ined in Section
35	25-9-147, Mississippi Code of 1972. Paym	nent	from these funds shall
36	be in accordance with the Variable Compe	ensat	ion Plan promulgated
37	by the Mississippi State Personnel Board	d. It	is the Legislature's
38	intention that no employee's salary fall	s be	low the minimum salary
39	established by the Mississippi State Per	sonn	el Board.
40	The State Personnel Board shall det	ermi	ne and publish the
41	projected annual cost of "Personal Servi	ces"	based on monthly and
42	year-to-date payroll expenditures in com	mplia	nce with the
43	provisions of this act.		

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44	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
45	responsibility to ensure that no single personnel action or
46	combination of personnel actions, when annualized, exceeds the
47	Fiscal Year 2026 appropriation for "Personal Services" with the
48	exception of escalated funds. Further, it shall be the agency's
49	responsibility to ensure that funds required to be appropriated
50	for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal
51	Year 2026 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or
52	positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the
53	Mississippi Legislature.
54	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change
55	"Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the
56	agency has taken or will take an action that would cause the
57	agency to exceed the funds appropriated in this act when
58	annualized for Fiscal Year 2026 or increase the need for "Personal
59	Services" for Fiscal Year 2027, when annualized, the State
60	Personnel Board shall process no salary actions until such time as
61	the requirements of the provisions of this section are met with
62	the exception of new hires determined to be essential for the
63	agency.
64	When used in this section, "Vacancy Funding" shall mean funds
65	included in the Total Personal Services amount listed above and
66	designated for approved vacancies in Fiscal Year 2026. These funds
67	are to be utilized to increase the number of filled headcounts
68	that were authorized but unfilled as of the last day of Fiscal

- 69 Year 2025. If the agency fills additional headcounts after May 1,
- 70 2025, until the end of Fiscal Year 2025, the amount of available
- 71 Vacancy Funding may be proportionally reduced to reflect the
- 72 updated number of filled headcounts. The agency shall be
- 73 responsible for ensuring that "Vacancy Funding" is used to
- 74 increase headcounts and not for promotions, title changes,
- 75 in-range salary adjustments, or any other mechanism for increasing
- 76 salaries for current employees.
- 77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 78 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 79 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 80 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 81 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 82 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or headcounts 83
- 84 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 85 appropriated level. Unless specifically noted, all Fiscal Year
- 86 2025 escalated headcounts have been accounted for and shall be
- 87 converted to authorized time-limited headcounts.
- 88 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 89 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 90 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are

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- 91 withdrawn and no longer available.
- 92 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A 93

- 94 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 95 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 96 If the agency's total authorized headcount decreases from
- 97 Fiscal Year 2025 to Fiscal Year 2026, it will be the agency's
- 98 discretion as to what headcounts are removed.
- 99 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 100 Mississippi Board of Registered Professional Geologists shall
- 101 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 102 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 103 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 104 maintained for Fiscal Year 2025. It is further the intention of
- 105 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 106 2027 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 107 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 108 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request
- 109 process.
- 110 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 111 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 112 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 113 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 114 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 115 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 116 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 117 made without competitive bids.

118	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
119	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
120	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
121	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
122	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
123	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
124	actions contrary to this provision.
125	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
126	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
127	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
128	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
129	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
130	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
131	SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
132	and after July 1 2025
