1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC CONTRACTORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
8	Public Contractors, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
9	said board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
10	June 30, 2026\$ 4,319,483.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

42	year-to-date payroll expenditures in co	ompl	iance with the

44	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
45	responsibility to ensure that no single personnel action or
46	combination of personnel actions, when annualized, exceeds the
47	Fiscal Year 2026 appropriation for "Personal Services" with the
48	exception of escalated funds. Further, it shall be the agency's
49	responsibility to ensure that funds required to be appropriated
50	for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal
51	Year 2026 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or
52	positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the
53	Mississippi Legislature.
54	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change
55	"Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the
56	agency has taken or will take an action that would cause the
57	agency to exceed the funds appropriated in this act when
58	annualized for Fiscal Year 2026 or increase the need for "Personal
59	Services" for Fiscal Year 2027, when annualized, the State
60	Personnel Board shall process no salary actions until such time as
61	the requirements of the provisions of this section are met with
62	the exception of new hires determined to be essential for the
63	agency.
64	When used in this section, "Vacancy Funding" shall mean funds
65	included in the Total Personal Services amount listed above and
66	designated for approved vacancies in Fiscal Year 2026. These funds
67	are to be utilized to increase the number of filled headcounts
68	that were authorized but unfilled as of the last day of Fiscal

- 69 Year 2025. If the agency fills additional headcounts after May 1,
- 70 2025, until the end of Fiscal Year 2025, the amount of available
- 71 Vacancy Funding may be proportionally reduced to reflect the
- 72 updated number of filled headcounts. The agency shall be
- 73 responsible for ensuring that "Vacancy Funding" is used to
- 74 increase headcounts and not for promotions, title changes,
- 75 in-range salary adjustments, or any other mechanism for increasing
- 76 salaries for current employees.
- 77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 78 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 79 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 80 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 81 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 82 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 83 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or headcounts
- 84 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 85 appropriated level. Unless specifically noted, all Fiscal Year
- 86 2025 escalated headcounts have been accounted for and shall be
- 87 converted to authorized time-limited headcounts.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 89 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 90 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 91 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 93 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A

- 94 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 95 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 96 If the agency's total authorized headcount decreases from
- 97 Fiscal Year 2025 to Fiscal Year 2026, it will be the agency's
- 98 discretion as to what headcounts are removed.
- 99 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 100 Mississippi Board of Public Contractors shall maintain complete
- 101 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 102 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 103 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 104 Year 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 105 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be
- 106 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 107 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 108 provided during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.
- 109 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in this act, it is the
- 110 intention of the Legislature that the State Board of Contractors
- 111 may expend funds not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Thousand
- 112 Dollars (\$2,300,000.00) for the purpose of defraying the cost of
- 113 (1) enforcement as set forth in Section 31-3-21, Mississippi Code
- of 1972, (2) enlisting of any private collection firm(s) to locate
- 115 and collect any uncollected fines, and (3) administrative costs
- 116 associated with collections. Any funds spent for this purpose
- 117 shall be subject to a performance audit if requested by the
- 118 Appropriations Chairmen in either the House or Senate.

119	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that
120	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
121	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
122	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
123	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
124	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
125	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
126	made without competitive bids.

- SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with

 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their

 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for

 actions contrary to this provision.
- 134 SECTION 7. The Mississippi Board of Public Contractors is 135 authorized to escalate the appropriate funds not to exceed Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$62,000.00) for the purposes of 136 137 defraying the expenditures of increased lease agreements, 138 advertising, and licensing costs. Such escalation shall be made 139 under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 140 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 141
- 142 **SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 143 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

144	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upor
145	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
146	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
147	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
148	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
149	and after July 1, 2025.
