- RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. There is created and established within the
- Office of the Attorney General the "Civil Rights Division" which 7
- shall be charged with the investigation and prosecution of civil 8
- rights cases. The Attorney General shall employ the necessary 9
- 10 personnel to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 11 SECTION 2. (1) The Civil Rights Division shall investigate
- and prosecute civil and criminal cases which result from acts of 12
- discrimination against a person because of the actual or perceived 13
- race, color, ancestry, ethnicity, religion, national origin or 14
- 15 gender of the person.
- (2) The Civil Rights Division may bring an action in the 16
- 17 name of the state against any person who commits an act of
- discrimination against a person because of the actual or perceived 18
- race, color, ancestry, ethnicity, religion, national origin or 19
- 20 gender of the person.
- SECTION 3. The Legislature shall annually appropriate funds 21
- 22 to defray the costs of operating the Civil Rights Division.
- SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
- and after July 1, 1999. 24
