- 9 fund to each municipality in this state on a per capita basis,
- 10 using the population figures from the most recent federal census,
- 11 with no municipality receiving less than Five Thousand Dollars
- 12 (\$5,000.00). Funds received by municipalities pursuant to this
- 13 section may be expended for, but not limited to, the following
- 14 purposes:
- 15 (a) Law enforcement;
- 16 (b) Equipment, technology, supplies, contractual
- 17 services, including training and related travel, and commodities;
- 18 (c) State or federal crime prevention grant matching
- 19 requirements; and
- 20 (d) Any crime prevention programs implemented by more
- 21 than one (1) jurisdiction, which may include the State of
- 22 Mississippi and any of its agencies, departments or political
- 23 subdivisions, through the use of interlocal cooperation
- 24 agreements.
