## HOUSE BILL NO. 1386

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE ONE MILLION
  DOLLARS ANNUALLY FOR A RESEARCH CENTER FOR ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND
  OTHER DEMENTIA-RELATED DISEASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Legislature shall appropriate One Million
- 6 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) annually for the establishment and
- 7 operation of a research center for research concerning Alzheimer's
- 8 disease and other dementia-related diseases.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 10 and after July 1, 1999.
