HOUSE BILL NO. 1487  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF TALLAHATCHIE  
2 COUNTY TO EXPEND MONIES DERIVED FROM THE OPERATION OR LOCATION OF  
3 A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OR FACILITIES IN TALLAHATCHIE COUNTY FOR  
4 THE PURPOSE OF PAVING OF GRAVEL PUBLIC ROADS OF THE COUNTY OR  
5 PAYING OR MAKING PAYMENTS ON CERTAIN NOTES OR BONDS OF THE COUNTY;  
6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Tallahatchie  
9 County, in its discretion, may appropriate and expend monies  
10 derived from the operation or location of a correctional facility  
11 or facilities in Tallahatchie County for one or more of the  
12 following purposes:

13 (a) To pave gravel public roads of the county, which  
14 expenditures may include, but are not limited to, payment for  
15 materials, supplies, equipment, services or other necessary or  
16 desirable materials, services or things to accomplish the paving  
17 of such roads;

18 (b) To pay or make payments on notes of Tallahatchie  
19 County issued under Section 17-21-51 et seq., Mississippi Code of  
20 1972; and

21 (c) To pay or make payments on notes or bonds of  
22 Tallahatchie County issued under Section 19-5-21 et seq.,  
23 Mississippi Code of 1972.

24 (2) The authority granted under subsection (1) of this  
25 section shall not be construed to prohibit the expenditure of  
26 monies derived from the operation or location of a correctional  
27 facility or facilities in Tallahatchie County for any other  
28 purpose for which general funds of the county may be expended, or

29 to prohibit the expenditure of such monies for the paving of  
30 gravel public roads of the county or the resurfacing or repairing  
31 of nonstate aid roads that have already been paved.

32 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
33 and after its passage.
