HOUSE BILL NO. 1487 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF TALLAHATCHIE 1 2 COUNTY TO EXPEND MONIES DERIVED FROM THE OPERATION OR LOCATION OF A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OR FACILITIES IN TALLAHATCHIE COUNTY FOR 3 THE PURPOSE OF PAVING OF GRAVEL PUBLIC ROADS OF THE COUNTY OR 4 5 PAYING OR MAKING PAYMENTS ON CERTAIN NOTES OR BONDS OF THE COUNTY; 6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Tallahatchie 8 9 County, in its discretion, may appropriate and expend monies derived from the operation or location of a correctional facility 10 11 or facilities in Tallahatchie County for one or more of the following purposes: 12 13 (a) To pave gravel public roads of the county, which 14 expenditures may include, but are not limited to, payment for materials, supplies, equipment, services or other necessary or 15 desirable materials, services or things to accomplish the paving 16 of such roads; 17 18 (b) To pay or make payments on notes of Tallahatchie County issued under Section 17-21-51 et seq., Mississippi Code of 19 1972; and 20 21 (c) To pay or make payments on notes or bonds of Tallahatchie County issued under Section 19-5-21 et seq., 22 23 Mississippi Code of 1972. (2) The authority granted under subsection (1) of this 24 25 section shall not be construed to prohibit the expenditure of 26 monies derived from the operation or location of a correctional 27 facility or facilities in Tallahatchie County for any other purpose for which general funds of the county may be expended, or 28

32 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 33 and after its passage.
