## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 175

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE MISSISSIPPI 1 LEGISLATURE TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 3 ADMINISTRATION, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF 5 ALLOWING CERTAIN RETIRED LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE EMPLOYEES LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR RETIRED STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR RELATED 6 7 8 PURPOSES. WHEREAS, retired employees of a local institution, department 9 or agency and elected county officials who do not run for 10 11 reelection or who are defeated before being entitled to receive a 12 retirement allowance deserve to participate in the State Employees Life and Health Insurance Plan in the same manner as provided for 13
- 14 retired state employees; and

WHEREAS, at the present time, such employees have difficulty

- 16 in maintaining their insurance into retirement; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Administration, in
- 18 conjunction with the Public Employees retirement System, is the
- 19 appropriate agency to conduct such a study and to report the
- 20 findings to the Mississippi Legislature:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 22 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 23 THEREIN, That we do hereby memorialize the Mississippi Legislature
- 24 to require the Department of Finance and Administration, in
- 25 conjunction with the Public Employees Retirement System, to
- 26 conduct a comprehensive study of the feasibility of allowing
- 27 retired employees of a local institution, department or agency and
- 28 elected county officials who do not run for reelection, or who are
- 29 defeated before being entitled to receive a retirement allowance,

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- 30 to participate in the State Employees Life and Health Insurance
- 31 Plan in the same manner as provided for retired state employees;
- 32 to require the department to prepare and present to the Senate and
- 33 House Insurance Committees by December 15, 1999, the results of
- 34 the study and to include a proposed implementation timetable and
- 35 potential actuarial effects on the existing state employee health
- 36 plan; to require that the department use existing staff resources
- 37 and those of other agencies to conduct this study; and to require
- 38 that the department shall not employ a consultant or contractor
- 39 other than an actuary to conduct this study.
