HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 54

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING REPRESENTATIVE RAYMOND COMANS UPON
2 HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE MISSISSIPPI HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND
3 EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR HIS MANY YEARS OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE.

24 his faithful wife, Glenda Burkes, and their three children:
