4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Health
8	for the purpose of providing funds for the AIDS Drug Assistance
9	Program and for HIV prevention activities, as specified in Section
LO	2 of this act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and
L1	ending June 30, 2000\$1,000,000.00.
L2	SECTION 2. (1) The money appropriated by Section 1 of this
L3	act shall be expended by the State Department of Health as
L4	follows:
L5	(a) AIDS Drug Assistance Program \$ 500,000.00
L6	(b) HIV prevention activities \$ 500,000.00
L7	Total\$1,000,000.00
L8	(2) The department shall expend the sum authorized in
L9	subsection (1)(b) for HIV prevention activities to be conducted by
20	community-based health organizations geographically distributed
21	throughout the state. The department shall receive applications
22	for the funds from community-based health organizations, and shall
23	distribute the funds to eligible community-based health
24	organizations in the form of assistance grants.
25	SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
26	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund

- 27 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
- 28 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
- 29 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
- 30 officers in the manner provided by law.
