COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2712

- 2 PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WITH A NATIVE SON OR DAUGHTER NONRESIDENT 3 LIFETIME SPORTSMAN LICENSE OR A RESIDENT LIFETIME SPORTSMAN
- 4 LICENSE MAY TAKE DOE ON CERTAIN LANDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 49-7-41. (1) The commission may set the bag limits for game
- 9 animals, birds and fish, unless the bag limits are established by
- 10 the Legislature by statute. This subsection shall stand repealed
- 11 on July 1, 2000.
- 12 (2) (a) The bag limit on buck deer is one (1) buck per day,
- 13 not to exceed three (3) per license year. Only buck deer with
- 14 antlers of four (4) points or greater may be taken.
- 15 (b) The bag limit on antlerless deer is one (1) per
- 16 day, not to exceed five (5) per license year; except that two (2)
- 17 additional antlerless deer per license year may be taken with a
- 18 bow and arrow. Antlerless deer may be taken only in the areas
- 19 prescribed by order of the commission. It is illegal to take a
- 20 spotted fawn in any season.
- 21 (c) It is unlawful for a nonresident to kill an
- 22 antlerless deer except: (i) a nonresident may take antlerless
- 23 <u>deer</u> on lands that <u>the</u> title is vested in the nonresident or on
- 24 lands that the nonresident has leased the hunting and fishing
- 25 rights; or (ii) a nonresident who has a native son or daughter
- 26 <u>nonresident lifetime sportsman license or a resident lifetime</u>
- 27 sportsman license may take anterless deer on private lands,

- 28 <u>wildlife management areas or national wildlife refuges</u>.
- 29 (3) The bag limit on antlerless deer set by this section
- 30 shall not apply to private lands under the deer management
- 31 assistance program or the fee-based antlerless program as approved
- 32 by the department.
- 33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 1999.
