- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO REGULATE THE KEEPING IN CAPTIVITY OF WILD ANIMALS BY A PERSON; TO AUTHORIZE A PERMIT AND A FEE FOR SUCH POSSESSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Commission on Wildlife, A person may
- 6 lawfully possess an orphaned white-tailed deer if the person has a
- 7 permit from the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. A
- 8 person must apply for a permit within thirty (30) days of the date
- 9 of possession. The Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks
- 10 may establish a fee for the permit not to exceed Twenty-five
- 11 Dollars (\$25.00).
- 12 (2) The person must abide by the following conditions of the
- 13 permit:
- 14 (a) No permitted animal shall be allowed to breed and
- 15 produce offspring. Any offspring of permitted animals shall be
- 16 reported to the department within seven (7) days.
- 17 (b) Male deer must be neutered.
- 18 (c) Permitted animals shall not be sold or transferred
- 19 to another person without prior written approval from the
- 20 department.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after its passage.
