## SENATE BILL NO. 2935 (As Passed the Senate)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE SELLING OF SKINS BY A TRAPPER; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 1

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 49-7-13. (1) Any resident of the state sixteen (16) years 8
- of age or older, upon application \* \* \*, is entitled to receive a 9
- 10 state trapper's license with tag for the sum of Twenty-five
- Dollars (\$25.00), together with the fee provided in Section 11
- 49-7-17 to the officer issuing same. This license shall be 12
- 13 required of each helper or assistant sixteen (16) years of age or
- older employed or used by a trapper. 14
- 15 (2) No person shall trap or set a trap on lands in which the
- record title is vested in another person unless he has a prior 16
- 17 agreement with the landowner which allows him to trap or set a
- trap on the lands of the landowner. 18
- (3) Every trap shall have an identification number attached 19
- 20 to traps by a metal tag or permanently inscribed, etched or
- stamped on traps and every trapper shall be required to visit his 21
- 22 traps at least every thirty-six (36) hours. The conservation
- officer shall be authorized to take up any traps not properly 23
- 24 marked.
- 25 No person shall place or set a trap on or within one
- hundred (100) feet of any street or public road. Public roads 26
- 27 shall not be construed to mean public waterways.

- 28 (5) This section shall not apply to a landowner trapping on
- 29 his own lands except subsection (4).
- 30 (6) A holder of a trapping license shall be allowed to catch
- 31 and sell skins of fur-bearing and predatory animals during
- 32 <u>trapping season</u>. The meat of legally acquired raccoons and
- 33 <u>muskrats may also be bought and sold during trapping season.</u>
