- 9 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Harrison County,
- 10 Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to
- 11 purchase appropriate insurance to provide protection for a loss in
- 12 tax revenue derived from the operation of cruise vessels on which
- 13 legal gaming is conducted when such loss in revenue results from a
