SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 610

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL NO.
3 519, 1999 REGULAR SESSION, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A HEALTH
4 CARE TRUST FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY INTO WHICH SHALL BE
5 DEPOSITED MONIES FROM THE SETTLEMENT OF THE LAWSUIT AGAINST
6 TOBACCO COMPANIES BY THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE THAT THE
7 PRINCIPAL OF THE TRUST FUND SHALL REMAIN INVIOLEATE AND SHALL NEVER
8 BE EXPENDED; TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES IN THE TRUST FUND THAT ARE
9 SUBJECT TO EXPENDITURE SHALL BE EXPENDED EXCLUSIVELY FOR HEALTH
10 ISSUES; TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES IN THE TRUST FUND SHALL BE INVESTED
11 IN ANY OF THE INVESTMENTS AUTHORIZED FOR THE MISSISSIPPI PREPAID
12 AFFORDABLE COLLEGE TUITION PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
14 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the following
15 bill is hereby exempt from the timetable for consideration of
16 bills provided by Joint Rule No. 40, and that consent is hereby
17 given for further consideration of House Bill No. 519, 1999
18 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A HEALTH CARE TRUST
19 FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY INTO WHICH SHALL BE DEPOSITED MONIES
20 FROM THE SETTLEMENT OF THE LAWSUIT AGAINST TOBACCO COMPANIES BY
21 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PRINCIPAL OF THE
22 TRUST FUND SHALL REMAIN INVIOLEATE AND SHALL NEVER BE EXPENDED; TO
23 PROVIDE THAT MONIES IN THE TRUST FUND THAT ARE SUBJECT TO
24 EXPENDITURE SHALL BE EXPENDED EXCLUSIVELY FOR HEALTH ISSUES; TO
25 PROVIDE THAT MONIES IN THE TRUST FUND SHALL BE INVESTED IN ANY OF
26 THE INVESTMENTS AUTHORIZED FOR THE MISSISSIPPI PREPAID AFFORDABLE
27 COLLEGE TUITION PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
