- 3 WHEREAS, Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College will honor
- 4 Head Basketball Coach Bob Weathers for his 800th win with a
- 5 reception at the Liaison on the Perkinston campus on March 29,
- 6 1999; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in the entire 60-year history of the National Junior
- 8 College Athletic Association (NJCAA), only three other coaches
- 9 have ever reached the lofty plateau of recording 800 victories;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, Weathers' career tally sheet lists an 815 victories
- 12 against just 306 losses, a mark that includes nine state
- 13 championships and three trips to Hutchinson, Kansas, for the
- 14 national tournament -- 1990, 1991, and 1993; and
- WHEREAS, Bob Weathers began his coaching career as an
- 16 assistant for two seasons at the University of Southern
- 17 Mississippi, his alma mater, before guiding Picayune High School
- 18 for one season; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 1960, then Gulf Coast President Dr. J.J. Hayden,
- 20 Jr., chose Weathers to lead the Bulldogs' fortunes, and Gulf Coast
- 21 fans have been thankful ever since; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Bob Weathers entered the National Junior College
- 23 Athletic Association (NJCAA) Hall of Fame in 1994 and averages an
- 24 astounding 21 wins per season against an average of just five
- 25 losses; and
- 26 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to commend and

- 27 recognize the extraordinary accomplishments of its citizens:
