## HOUSE BILL NO. 42

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 ESTABLISH THE PER DIEM COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF COUNTY PORT AND
- 3 HARBOR COMMISSIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 59-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 59-11-3. (1) Any county port and harbor commission \* \* \*
- 8 created pursuant to Section 59-11-1 shall be appointed as follows:
- 9 two (2) members shall be appointed by the Governor, one (1) from
- 10 each of the two (2) municipalities of the county, \* \* \* which
- 11 appointments shall be made from those persons recommended and
- 12 nominated by the governing authorities of the municipalities, and
- 13 shall be qualified electors of the county; <u>and</u> five (5) members
- 14 shall be appointed by the board of supervisors of such county,
- 15 each supervisor to recommend the appointment of one (1) member
- 16 thereof. The members of the county port and harbor commission
- 17 shall serve for terms concurrent with that of the Governor and the
- 18 board of supervisors making such appointment.
- 19 (2) Each member of the county port and harbor commission
- 20 shall receive per diem compensation in the amount of Sixty-five
- 21 Dollars (\$65.00) for each day engaged in attendance of meetings of

- 22 the county port and harbor commission and shall be reimbursed for
- 23 <u>mileage and actual travel expenses at the rate authorized for</u>
- 24 <u>county employees under Section 25-3-41.</u>
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after October 1, 2000.
