- 3 FIGHTERS IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE FIRE FIGHTER LICENSE
- 4 TAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:[%CN%1]
- 8 27-19-56.1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a fire
- 9 fighter, including a career fire fighter, a volunteer fire fighter
- 10 or an industrial fire fighter, employed by or in the service of
- 11 any municipality, county, fire district, state agency or industry
- 12 in the state who is a resident of this state, or who is a retired
- 13 fire fighter who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the
- 14 road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration
- 15 fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers,
- 16 pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon
- 17 payment of <u>any</u> additional fee <u>required under</u> subsection (3) of
- 18 this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each
- 19 motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
- 20 fire fighter or retired fire fighter. The distinctive license
- 21 tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be agreed
- 22 upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Fire Fighters

- 23 Association and the State Tax Commission, shall consist of such
- 24 letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish
- 25 each license tag and may, in the discretion of the State Tax
- 26 Commission, display the county name.
- 27 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 28 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- 29 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such
- 30 distinctive license tags (a) shall present to the issuing official
- 31 proof of their employment or service as a fire fighter by
- 32 presentation of the applicant's official fire fighter
- 33 identification card or a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 34 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 35 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry by or for
- 36 whom the applicant is employed or serves as a fire fighter; or (b)
- 37 shall present proof that they are a retired fire fighter by
- 38 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 39 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 40 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry from whom
- 41 the fire fighter retired. The application and <u>any</u> additional fee
- 42 imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three percent
- 43 (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 44 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 45 prescribed by the commission. The portion of <u>any</u> additional fee
- 46 required to be imposed under subsection (3) of this section that
- 47 <u>is</u> retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
- 48 county general fund.
- 49 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 50 after July 1, 2000, any person, except a volunteer fire fighter,
- 51 who applies for a distinctive license tag under this section shall
- 52 pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
- 53 each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which

54 shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional 55 fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the 56 vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due 57 and payable at the time the original application is made for a 58 distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually 59 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains 60 the distinctive license tag. <u>Volunteer fire fighters shall be</u> exempt from the payment of an additional fee. If the owner does 61 not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, or if the owner 62 63 retires or resigns from or otherwise vacates his employment or

service as a fire fighter, he must surrender it to the local

- (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 66 67 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the 68 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of 69 70 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an 71 amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees collected <u>from the issuance of</u> such distinctive license tag<u>s</u> under 72 73 this section to the State General Fund, and the remainder of such 74 additional fees collected shall be distributed by the State 75 Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created in Section 76 7-9-70.
- 77 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
 78 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
 79 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
 80 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
 81 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license

85 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 86 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 87 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 88 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 89 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 90 91 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 92 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 93 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular

distinctive license tags issued under this section.

subsections (1) through (6) of this section, any person who presents proof of his employment or service as a fire fighter in the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section, may be issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a fire fighter.

The distinctive license tag decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Fire Fighters Association and the State Tax

Commission; however, the State Tax Commission shall have final approval of the size, color and design. The distinctive license tag decals shall be prepared and sold at Two Dollars (\$2.00) each through the Mississippi Fire Fighters Training Academy; however, volunteer fire fighters shall be exempt from the payment of such
