- 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 9 63-3-519. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or peace
- officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway 10
- 11 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
- radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or 12
- highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used: 13
- (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a 14
- municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more 15
- 16 upon the public streets of the municipality;
- (b) By any college or university campus police force 17
- within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand 18
- (2,000) students are enrolled; 19
- (c) By municipal law enforcement officers in any 20
- municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand 21
- (15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally 22

- 23 designated highways lying within the corporate limits; and
- 24 (d) By security officers appointed under Article 5,
- 25 Chapter 9, Title 51, Mississippi Code of 1972, by the Board of
- 26 <u>Directors of the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District on roads</u>
- 27 and streets located on property owned by or under the jurisdiction
- 28 <u>or control of the district.</u>
- 29 <u>(2)</u> The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol <u>shall</u> not set up
- 30 radar on highways within municipalities with a population in
- 31 excess of fifteen thousand (15,000) according to the latest

- 33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2000.
