HOUSE BILL NO. 117

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2	AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO WAIVE THE
3	REQUIREMENT FOR THE TAKING OF A WRITTEN TEST AND SKILL TEST BY AN
4	APPLICANT FOR A MISSISSIPPI DRIVER'S LICENSE WHO, AT THE TIME OF
5	APPLICATION, HOLDS A VALID MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED

- 6 BY ANOTHER STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 63-1-33. It shall be the duty of the license examiner, when
- 11 application is made for an operator's license or temporary driving
- 12 permit, to test the applicant's ability to read and understand
- 13 road signs and to give the required signals as adopted by the
- 14 National Advisory Committee on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and
- 15 the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators.
- The commissioner shall have prepared and administer a test
- 17 composed of at least ten (10) questions relating to the safe
- 18 operation of a motor vehicle and testing the applicant's knowledge
- 19 of the proper operation of a motor vehicle.
- 20 Prior to the administration of the test the license examiner
- 21 shall inspect the horn, lights, brakes, inspection certificate and
- 22 vehicle registration of the motor vehicle which the applicant
- 23 expects to operate while being tested, and if he finds that any of
- 24 the aforementioned items are deficient, no license or endorsement
- 25 shall be issued to the applicant until same have been repaired.
- The commissioner, in his discretion, may waive the
- 27 requirement for the taking of a written test and skill test by an
- 28 applicant who, at the time of application, holds a valid motor

- 29 <u>vehicle driver's license issued by another state.</u>
- 30 Except as otherwise provided by Section 63-1-6, when
- 31 application is made for an original motorcycle endorsement or a
- 32 restricted motorcycle operator's license, the applicant shall be
- 33 required to pass a written test which consists of questions
- 34 relating to the safe operation of a motorcycle and a skill test
- 35 similar to the "Motorcycle Operator Skill Test," which is endorsed
- 36 by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators. The
- 37 commissioner may exempt any applicant from the skill test if the
- 38 applicant presents a certificate showing successful completion of
- 39 a course approved by the commissioner, which includes a similar
- 40 examination of skills needed in the safe operation of a
- 41 motorcycle.
- 42 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2000.
