2	<u>SECTION 1.</u> The board of trustees of each public community of

3	junior college shall provide for an increase in the salaries of

- the academic faculty of not less than that amount necessary to 14
- 15 raise the salaries to the midpoint between the average salaries of
- the public secondary schools' teaching personnel and the salaries 16
- of the academic faculty of the state institutions of higher 17
- learning. As an alternative, the board of trustees of a community 18
- or junior college may provide the academic faculty a salary 19
- 20 increase of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00).
- The Legislature shall appropriate the funds necessary to 21

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
- and after July 1, 2000. 24
