Any telephone solicitor who makes an unsolicited telephonic sales call to a residential telephone number shall: 8 Make calls between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 9 (a) p.m., Central Standard Time, Monday through Friday, and between 10 the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Saturdays (no calls shall 11 be made on Sundays); 12 Identify himself or herself by his or her true 13 (b) first and last names and the business on whose behalf he or she is 14 soliciting immediately upon making contact by telephone with the 15 person who is the object of the telephone solicitation; * * * 16 (c) Discontinue the call immediately if at any time 17 during the conversation the person being solicited expresses 18 disinterest in continuing the call or sales presentation; and 19 (d) Immediately end any recorded message being played 20 for a consumer when the consumer ends the telephone connection. 21
