- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Any franchisor of motor vehicles may not
- 6 coerce, or attempt to coerce, any franchisee to accept delivery of
- 7 any motor vehicle, parts, accessories or any other commodities
- 8 connected therewith, which are not ordered by the franchisee; nor
- 9 may such franchisor withhold or delay delivery of motor vehicles
- 10 out of the ordinary course of business; discriminate against any
- 11 franchisee by the allocation or through the withholding from
- 12 delivery of certain models of motor vehicles ordered by a
- 13 franchisee out of the ordinary course of business; or unfairly
- 14 change or amend unilaterally a franchisee's allotment of motor
- 15 vehicles or quota in a sales contest without reasonable cause.
- 16 Any franchisor who violates this section shall be civilly liable
- 17 for all costs incurred by a franchisee as a result of such
- 18 violation.
- 19 (2) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 20 2001.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

22 and after July 1, 2000.
