- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The governing authority of any political
- 5 subdivision or local or other governmental authority of the state
- 6 is precluded and preempted from bringing suit to recover against
- 7 any firearms or ammunition manufacturer, trade association, or
- 8 dealer for damages for injury, death, or loss or to seek other
- 9 injunctive relief resulting from or relating to the lawful design,
- 10 manufacture, marketing, or sale of firearms or ammunition. The
- 11 authority to bring such actions as may be authorized by law shall
- 12 be reserved exclusively to the state.
- 13 (2) This section shall not prohibit the governing authority
- 14 of a political subdivision or local or other governing authority
- 15 of the state from bringing an action against a firearms or
- 16 ammunition manufacturer, trade association, or dealer for breach
- 17 of contract as to firearms or ammunition purchased by the
- 18 political subdivision or local authority of the state.
- 19 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The provisions of this act shall be applicable to
- 20 all claims existing or actions pending on its effective date and
- 21 all claims arising or actions filed on and after its effective

- 22 date.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2000.
