HOUSE BILL NO. 453

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF
2 REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTRACTING WITH
3 ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE THERAPEUTIC HORSEBACK RIDING SERVICES FOR
4 DISABLED INDIVIDUALS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of
9 Rehabilitation Services for the purpose of contracting with one or
10 more nonprofit organizations to provide therapeutic horseback
11 riding services for disabled individuals who would benefit from
12 those services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and
13 ending June 30, 2001.....\$50,000.00.

14 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
15 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
16 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
17 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
18 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
19 officers in the manner provided by law.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after July 1, 2000.
