## HOUSE BILL NO. 463

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-17-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,

2 TO INCREASE THE MONETARY THRESHOLD THAT REQUIRES A COUNTY TO

3 EMPLOY A QUALIFIED ENGINEER ON PROJECTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR

4 RECONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY ROADS OR BRIDGES; AND FOR RELATED

5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. Section 65-17-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

9 65-17-201. The boards of supervisors of the several counties

10 of the State of Mississippi are authorized and empowered at their

11 discretion to employ, as county engineer, a civil engineer or

12 person qualified to perform the duties of a county engineer, and

13 such assistant engineers as may be necessary. On all projects for

14 the construction or reconstruction of a bridge which will cost

more than <u>Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)</u>, or for the

16 construction or reconstruction of roads which will cost more than

17 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per mile, the employment of an

18 engineer qualified under the chapter on engineers shall be

19 obligatory, whether the work is being done by the county or by a

20 separate district, and whether the work is to be done by contract

21 or otherwise; however, in obligatory cases the employment may be

22 for the particular work, rather than for a term.
