## HOUSE BILL NO. 472

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR PERSONS WHO MAKE, ISSUE, USE OR
- 3 DISPLAY A FALSE MOTOR VEHICLE CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION OR WHO
- 4 DISPLAY OR ISSUE A MOTOR VEHICLE CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION WITHOUT
- 5 A PROPER INSPECTION HAVING BEEN MADE; TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-15,
- 6 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC
- 7 SAFETY TO CAUSE INSPECTIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION STATIONS
- 8 AT LEAST TWICE ANNUALLY; TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-29, MISSISSIPPI
- 9 CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; AND
- 10 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 SECTION 1. Section 63-13-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 63-13-13. (1) No person shall make, issue or knowingly use
- 15 any imitation or counterfeit of an official certificate of
- 16 inspection.
- 17 (2) No person shall <u>issue</u>, display or cause or permit to be
- 18 displayed upon any vehicle any certificate of inspection and
- 19 approval knowing the same to be fictitious or issued for another
- 20 vehicle or issued without proper inspection having been made.
- 21 (3) Any person who violates the provisions of this section,
- 22 upon conviction, shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished
- 23 by a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or
- 24 <u>sentenced to the custody of the Department of Corrections for one</u>
- 25 <u>(1) year, or both.</u>

- SECTION 2. Section 63-13-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 27 amended as follows:
- 28 63-13-15. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
- 29 annually issue permits for and furnish instructions and all
- 30 necessary forms to official inspection stations for the inspection
- 31 of vehicles as required by this chapter in the issuance of
- 32 official certificates of inspection and approval.
- 33 (2) Application for permit shall be made on an official form
- 34 and shall be granted only when the Commissioner of Public Safety
- 35 is satisfied that the station is properly equipped and has
- 36 competent personnel to make such inspections and that such
- 37 inspections will be properly conducted. A fee of Ten Dollars
- 38 (\$10.00) shall be charged any person or facility seeking a permit
- 39 as an official inspection station, or a renewal thereof, for the
- 40 purpose of defraying the cost of administering the processing of
- 41 the application.
- 42 (3) The person making the actual inspection for the station
- 43 or under whose immediate personal supervision such inspection is
- 44 made shall have not less than one (1) year's practical experience
- 45 as an automotive mechanic. No person shall be designated by such
- 46 station to make such inspections for it unless the person has been
- 47 approved for that purpose by the Department of Public Safety.
- 48 (4) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall properly
- 49 supervise and cause inspections to be made of such stations at
- 50 <u>least twice annually</u> and may, after reasonable notice, suspend or
- 51 revoke and require the surrender of the permit issued to a station
- 52 which he finds is not properly equipped or conducted. The
- 53 Commissioner of Public Safety shall maintain and post at the
- 54 Office of the Department of Public Safety lists of all stations
- 55 holding permits and of those whose permits have been suspended or
- 56 revoked.

- 57 SECTION 3. Section 63-13-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 58 amended as follows:
- 59 63-13-29. Except as otherwise provided in Section 63-13-13,
- 60 any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be
- 61 guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be punished by a
- 62 fine of not more than <a>One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00)</a>, or
- 63 sentenced to not more than six (6) months in the county jail, or
- 64 both.
- 65 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2000.
