- 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-29-152, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 7
- 41-29-152. (1) Any person who violates Section 41-29-139 8
- with reference to a controlled substance listed in Schedules I, 9
- 10 II, III, IV or V as set out in Sections 41-29-113 to 41-29-121, or
- 11 41-29-313, Mississippi Code of 1972, inclusive, and has in his
- possession any firearm, either at the time of the commission of 12
- 13 the offense or at the time any arrest is made, may be punished by
- a fine up to twice that authorized by Section 41-29-139, or 14
- 15 41-29-313, or by a term of imprisonment or confinement up to twice
- that authorized by Section 41-29-139 or 41-29-313, or both. 16
- "Firearm" means any weapon, including a starter gun, 17
- which will or is designed to or may readily be converted to expel 18
- a projectile by the action of an explosive. 19
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after its passage.
