HOUSE BILL NO. 830

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
2 309 IN MARSHALL COUNTY AS THE "J.P. WOODS HIGHWAY"; AND FOR
3 RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. (1) That portion of Mississippi Highway 309 in
6 Marshall County beginning at Watson and extending northerly to the
7 Mississippi/Tennessee state line is designated and shall be known
8 as the "J.P. Woods Highway."

9 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
10 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching such highway.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
12 and after its passage.
