- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 7-7-38, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
- 2 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT AGENCIES ACQUIRING COMPUTER EQUIPMENT OR
- 3 SERVICES WITH AN AGGREGATE COST OF \$1,000,000.00 OR MORE SHALL
- 4 DRAW ALL PAYMENTS FOR THE EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES FROM A SINGLE FUND
- 5 IN THE STATE TREASURY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 8 7-7-38, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 9 7-7-38. (1) Whenever any agency of state government engages
- 10 in the acquisition of computer equipment or services as defined in
- 11 Section 25-53-3, with an aggregate cost of One Million Dollars
- 12 (\$1,000,000.00) or more, all payments and purchases associated
- 13 with the project, from any major object of expenditure, shall be
- 14 drawn from a single fund established in the State Treasury.
- 15 (2) The State Fiscal Officer shall not approve the payment
- 16 of any funds for the acquisition of computer equipment or services
- 17 for any agency unless the payments are drawn on the single fund in
- 18 the State treasury established under the provisions of subsection
- 19 (1) of this section.
- 20 (3) For purposes of this section, the term "payments and
- 21 purchases associated with the project" means any payment of funds
- 22 to any person, firm, or entity, public or private, for any

- 23 equipment, service, or other thing of value that was necessary to
- 24 the successful accomplishment of the acquisition of the computer
- 25 equipment or services.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2000.
