HOUSE BILL NO. 870

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY 2 IN NEWTON COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO 3 PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION 4 COMMISSION; TO DELETE TWO SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN NEWTON COUNTY 5 FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO RETURN THEM TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF NEWTON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the 9 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600) 10 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3. 11 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway 12 13 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and 14 15 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the 16 designated state highway system, are declared to be the state 17 highway system of Mississippi: 18 Central District - Newton County: 19 20 Decatur Street beginning on the north side of the 21 intersection of Third Street and Decatur Street, and 22 proceeding northward to the beginning of state maintenance south of U.S. Highway 80, all within the 23

City of Newton.

The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall 25 SECTION 2. maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the 26 27 highway designated in Section 1 of this act in the same manner and 28 upon the same terms and conditions as set out in Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. However, the City of Newton shall not 29 30 be required to provide to the Mississippi Department of Transportation any right-of-way with a width any greater than the 31 width of right-of-way that existed at the time that the highway 32 segment described in Section 1(2) of this act was returned to the 33 jurisdiction of the City of Newton. 34

35 SECTION 3. The following highways are deleted from the state 36 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 37 Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the 38 governing authorities of the City of Newton:

39 <u>Central District - Newton County:</u>

That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15 40 (a) beginning south of Interstate 20 at the intersection of 41 42 Old Mississippi Highway 15 and present Mississippi 43 Highway 15 and extending southwesterly for approximately 44 .033 miles, all within the City of Newton; and That section of Old Mississippi Highway 15 located 45 (b) 46 between U.S. Highway 80 and Decatur Street, all within the City of Newton. 47 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48

49 and after its passage.
