## HOUSE BILL NO. 882 (As Passed the House)

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2	PROVIDE THAT ALL JURORS WHO APPEAR FOR JURY DUTY SHALL RECEIVE
3	FULL COMPENSATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25-7-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 7 25-7-61. (1) Fees of jurors shall be payable as follows:
- 8 (a) Grand jurors and petit jurors in the chancery,
- 9 county, circuit and special eminent domain courts shall be paid an
- 10 amount to be set by the board of supervisors, not to be less than
- 11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day and not to be greater than
- 12 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day, plus mileage authorized in Section
- 13 25-3-41. In the trial of all cases where jurors are in charge of
- 14 bailiffs and are not permitted to separate, the sheriff with the
- 15 approval of the trial judge may pay for room and board of jurors
- 16 on panel for actual time of trial.

amended as follows:

- All jurors who appear shall receive \* \* \* compensation as provided by this section.
- 19 (b) Jurors making inquisitions of idiocy, lunacy or of
- 20 unsound mind and jurors on coroner's inquest shall be paid Five
- 21 Dollars (\$5.00) per day plus mileage authorized in Section 25-3-41
- 22 by the county treasurer on order of the board of supervisors on
- 23 certificate of the clerk of the chancery court in which such
- 24 inquisition is held.
- 25 (c) Jurors in the justice courts shall be paid an
- 26 amount of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day and not more

- 27 than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per day, to be established by the
- 28 board of supervisors. In all criminal cases in the justice court
- 29 wherein the prosecution fails, the fees of jurors shall be paid by
- 30 the county treasurer on order of the board of supervisors on
- 31 certificate of the county attorney in all counties that have
- 32 county attorneys, otherwise by the justice court judge.
- 33 (2) Any juror may return the fees provided as compensation
- 34 for service as a juror to the county which paid for such person's
- 35 service as a juror. The fees returned to the county may be
- 36 earmarked for a particular purpose to be selected by the juror,
- 37 including:
- 38 (a) The local public library;
- 40 (c) The Mississippi Fire Fighters Memorial Burn Center
- 41 fund created in Section 7-9-70, Mississippi Code of 1972; or
- 42 (d) Any other governmental agency.
- 43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2000.
