- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15-1-40, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 codified as follows:
- 7 15-1-40. No action to recover damages for any deficiency,
- defect, omission, error or miscalculation in a survey or plat 8
- 9 shall be brought against a professional land surveyor, or the
- employee of a professional land surveyor, who performed or 10
- furnished the survey or plat unless it is filed within six (6) 11
- 12 years from the date of the survey or plat. The cause of action in
- 13 such cases shall accrue when services are rendered as shown from
- the date on the survey or plat or the date of a supplement or 14
- 15 amendment to the survey or plat. Any action not instituted within
- the period provided by this section shall be forever barred. 16
- In the event the cause of action shall have been fraudulently 17
- concealed from the knowledge of the person entitled thereto, the 18
