(1) (a) From and after January 1, 2001, all commodities, products, goods, wares and merchandise held for 8 resale by a manufacturer, distributor, wholesale merchant or 9 retail merchant shall be exempt from ad valorem taxation as 10 11 follows: (i) For the 2001 calendar year, one-third (1/3) of 12 13 the assessed value of such property shall be exempt from ad 14 valorem taxation; (ii) For the 2002 calendar year, two-thirds (2/3) 15 of the assessed value of such property shall be exempt from ad 16 valorem taxation; and 17 18 (iii) For the 2003 calendar year and each calendar year thereafter, such property shall be exempt from ad valorem 19 20 taxation. 21 (b) The exemption provided in this subsection (1) shall not apply to ad valorem taxes for school district purposes. 22 23 (2) The exemption provided in this section shall be in addition to all other exemptions heretofore granted by the laws of 2.4 25 the State of Mississippi. 26 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall affect or defeat any 27 claim, assessment, appeal, suit, right or cause of action for taxes due or accrued under the ad valorem tax laws before the date 2.8

No. 1023 00\HR03\R1161 PAGE 1 29 on which this act becomes effective, whether such claims, assessments, appeals, suits or actions have been begun before the 30 31 date on which this act becomes effective or are begun thereafter; and the provisions of the ad valorem tax laws are expressly 32 continued in full force, effect and operation for the purpose of 33 the assessment, collection and enrollment of liens for any taxes 34 35 due or accrued and the execution of any warrant under such laws before the date on which this act becomes effective, and for the 36 imposition of any penalties, forfeitures or claims for failure to 37 38 comply with such laws.

39 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 2000.
